How to Set Up on a Windows PC (for VRChat Beginners)

Step 1: Check Your Computer

- Make sure you're using a Windows PC (not a Mac).
- You'll need an internet connection.
- Your PC should be able to run 3D games — if you can watch YouTube videos smoothly and your computer isn't super old, you're probably good!

Step 2: Install Steam

- Go to store.steampowered.com.
- Click Install Steam (top right corner) and download the Steam program.
- Open the file and follow the steps to install Steam on your computer.

Step 3: Create a Steam Account

- Once Steam is installed, open it and create a free account (or log in if you already have one).
- You'll need an email address and a password.

Step 4: Download VRChat

- Inside Steam, search for "VRChat" in the store.
- Click on the VRChat game (it's free) and hit Install.

Step 5: Create a VRChat Account (Optional but Recommended)

- When you first open VRChat, it will give you the option to log in with Steam or create a separate VRChat account.
- We recommend creating a VRChat account — it lets you save your progress, customize your avatar, and find friends easier.

Step 6: Launch VRChat

- Open VRChat from your Steam Library.
- Log in with your VRChat or Steam account.

Step 7: Find the Rink

- Use the VRChat Worlds Search to find our rink.
- Search by name (you'll get the exact world name/link from our website or event page).
- Click Join — and you'll teleport right into the virtual rink!

Step 8: Move Around

- Mouse to look around.
- W/A/S/D keys to move (like a regular PC game).
- Or plug in a controller for easier movement if you prefer!



Quick Notes:

- No headset required — you can fully enjoy VRChat and the rink on your computer screen!
- Optional: If you get a VR headset later, you can just connect it and keep using the same account.
- Always free to use — Steam and VRChat are free downloads.
